Science and Technology Entry Program (STEP) at Vaughn College

- Free program open to all high school students who are NY residents, are economically disadvantaged **or** are African American, Hispanic/Latinx, Alaskan Native or American Indian
 - Students who identify as economically disadvantaged will be required to provide tax documents for proof of income
- 11th and 12th grade students have the option to take the STEP courses and/or college credit
- An Accuplacer placement test is required, information can be found <u>here</u>
