

Senior Spring Checklist

- Be respectful of your peers! Everyone is on their own journey.
 - Update each admissions decision in Naviance and set your attending college
 - If you've been waitlisted (or if you intend to enroll at an international institution and have received a conditional acceptance), you must decide on an alternate college to attend and pay the deposit for that school.
 - Check financial aid packages and compare [here](#).
 - Contact your college counselor if you need help comparing offers of aid.
 - Many colleges (but not all) have a enrollment and deposit deadline of May 1st.
 - Submit your deposit for one school only (even if you are remaining on waitlists)
 - Set your attending college in Naviance.
 - Final grades will be sent automatically by the College Office by July 1st.
- Register for/attend accepted students events.
- Send official college course transcripts (such as College Now) to the college you will be attending.
 - Apply for scholarships ([Fastweb](#) and [Scholly](#) are good resources).
 - Ensure that your attending college is correctly indicated in your TAP application (if you applied).
 - TAP is the NYS scholarship for any college, public or private, in the state of NY. It's not too late to apply now if you haven't yet; you can do so [here](#).
 - Look out for emails to sign up for freshman orientation, and with instructions on choosing your housing and meal plans, if living on campus.
 - If taking out loans, complete loan applications through your college's website.
 - If you plan on requesting accommodations in college, please review [this document](#).
 - Obtain a copy of your immunization records from your doctor.
 - If you plan to take a gap year, you must follow instructions from the college you will ultimately be attending.
