If you've been waitlisted (or if you intend to enroll at an international institution and have received a
conditional acceptance), you must decide on an alternate college to attend and pay the deposit for that
school.
Check financial aid packages and compare <u>here</u> .
• Contact your college counselor if you need help comparing offers of aid.
Many colleges (but not all) have a enrollment and deposit deadline of May 1st.
Submit your deposit for one school only (even if you are remaining on waitlists)
Set your attending college in Naviance.
Final grades will be sent automatically by the College Office by July 1st.
Register for/attend accepted students events.
Send official college course transcripts (such as College Now) to the college you will be attending.
Apply for scholarships (<u>Fastweb</u> and <u>Scholly</u> are good resources).
Ensure that your attending college is correctly indicated in your TAP application (if you applied).
• TAP is the NYS scholarship for any college, public or private, in the state of NY. It's not too late to
apply now if you haven't yet; you can do so <u>here</u> .
Look out for emails to sign up for freshman orientation, and with instructions on choosing your housing
and meal plans, if living on campus.
If taking out loans, complete loan applications through your college's website.
If you plan on requesting accommodations in college, please review this document.
Obtain a copy of your immunization records from your doctor.
If you plan to take a gap year, you must follow instructions from the college you will ultimately be
attending.
